Consignment Requirements

Consignment must consist of the following:

Completed and signed consignment form

Catalog Fee - \$100 per lot (Non-Refundable)

This fee must accompany all consignments - No Exceptions

Breeding Certificates (Original)

Futurity Fee - \$100 per entry (Non-Refundable)

Health Papers - **Cattle must be listed on the health certificate with the animal's permanent ID#(Traceability Requirements).** If you have any questions, check with your vet or contact your states animal health commission.

Health Papers - The cattle must be listed on a health certificate with ID#'s and palpation. Semen test and scrotal circumference on bulls and palpation on females must be shown on the health certificate. Testing must be done within 30 days of sale date. ALL BULLS must pass a Breeding Soundness Evaluation (BSE). **The BSE can be filled out by a licensed Vet on the form provided by BBU or on the form issued by the Society of Theriogenology.** **Health Information:** A separate health certificate issued by a licensed veterinarian is required on each lot consigned with all required information appearing thereon:

1. All animals must show a negative test result for brucellosis and TB or be from a TB Free state and be noted on health papers. You do not have to TB test, unless you are from an area that requires it.
2. All bulls must be Trich tested (with negative result), Fertility tested, scrotal circumference and **BSE** test as stipulated above. **NO Virgin Bull Affidavits** will be accepted.
3. Palpation on each female.
4. Have your vet check all eligible females to be sure they are Calfhood Vaccinated. If the females you have consigned are Calfhood Vaccinated for Brucellosis, this information must be stated on your health papers. **Testing must be done within 30 days of Sale Date.** The health certificate must accompany all cattle upon delivery at the sale site.

This sale is open to futurity bulls, futurity heifers, bulls, 3n1's, pairs, bred cows and bred heifers. The following rules apply to each category. No advancer cattle will be accepted into the sale.

Futurity Bulls & Open Heifers - All futurity bulls and heifers MUST have been born between February 15th and April 15th, 2020. Only one animal per consignor in each category.

Futurity Bulls – Must have an official 205 day weight, yearling weight and ultrasound data recorded with BBU prior to April 1st, 2021. The scrotal circumference must be written on the health papers. Bulls not weighing more than 900 pounds at the time of judging will NOT make the sale.

Herd Bulls & Herd Bull Prospects - Bulls - The age requirement is 14 months to a maximum of 36 months. All consigned bulls not in the futurity MUST be in the bull test conducted at Bo Johnson's farm.

3-N-1's and Pairs - Maximum age requirement 84 months (7 years). Any female with a calf at side that is over 6 months of age must be bred back by the sixth month birth date of the calf. The oldest a calf can be shown at side is ten (10) months.

Bred Cows - 36 months to 84 months of age - Only the highest quality will be accepted. Bred cows should be bred 6+ months and should have production records to prove fertility.

Bred Heifers - Age limit is 15 months to 36 months. Any heifer over 24 months of age must be palpated safe in calf according to BBU's Terms and Conditions.

The sales committee will screen all cattle at the sale site before being allowed to sell. Screening will include but not limited to: Feet, Legs, Udders, muzzles, navals, disposition, conditioning, etc.

There will be no refunds of catalog or futurity fees for no shows or animals that are screened out by the sale committee.

Consignors are responsible for making sure their consignments have correct ID's and have correct permanent ID's on their consignments. Brands on all animals must be clipped to permit proper identification by BBU and Sale Management personnel.
